Biography of Honorary Grand Marshall - LT j.g. Kevin J. Quinn

Lieutenant Kevin Quinn was born in Camden, NJ. He is the youngest of five children to Captain James Quinn USN (Ret.) and the late Mrs. Anne Hollister Quinn. Kevin moved to Barrington, RI when he was six weeks old and spent most of his youth in town. He is a product of the Barrington Public School System and participated in numerous local Barrington civic and athletic programs. At Barrington High School, Kevin lettered in both Football and Track.

Kevin is a 2012 graduate of the Massachusetts Maritime Academy with B.S. in Marine Transportation and a U. S. Coast Guard Mariner's License - Third Mate (Any Ocean & Tonnage Vessel). He received his US Navy commission through the Strategic Sealift Commissioning Program and volunteered for Active Duty with his first assignment to the Amphibious Assault Ship, USS Peleliu (LHA 5). Kevin served as a Deck Division Officer in charge of ship's assault craft well deck operations and later as the Engineering Main Propulsion Division Officer. He earned his Surface Warfare Qualification during the ship's eight-month deployment to the Red Sea and Persian Gulf during Operation Enduring Freedom in support of anti-piracy operations. He deployed a second time for six more months, to the Western Pacific in support of National Interests in the Pacific Theater of Operations.

Kevin recently completed Agies Weapons System certification and will report to the Guided Missile Destroyer, USS Stetham as a Fire Control Officer. USS Stethem is home ported in Yokosuka, Japan as part of the USN forward Deployed Naval Forces in the Pacific. Lieutenant Quinn's awards include the Navy & Marine Corps Achievement Medal, the National Defense Medal, the Global War on Terrorism Medal, the Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, the Battle Efficiency Ribbon (2 awards) & the Sea Service Deployment Ribbon (2 awards).

Biography of Memorial Day Key Note Speaker – Mr. Anthony V. Arico, Jr.

Mr. Anthony V. Arico, Jr. is a native of Barrington, RI and is a veteran of the U.S. Air Force who served in the European Theater of Operations, including a tour in Tripoli, Libya prior to rule of Muammar Gaddafi. He also served a tour with the Strategic Air Command.

He is now retired having spent a career of thirty years as Deputy Director (and often as Director) of the Rhode Island Department of Business Regulation. As the Department's "Second in Command", he was involved in statutorily regulated businesses and professions and provided oversight over Rhode Island's Banking and Insurance Institutions. In addition, Anthony represented the Department of Business Regulation before various boards and commissions and served as its Legislative Liaison.

Mr. Arico was one of the original members of the Bristol County Water Authority, a past member of the Barrington Zoning Board of Review, and a twice a member of the Barrington Charter Review Commission. He also served on the search committee that recommended a new Superintendent for Barrington Public Schools. He is a Chairman Emeritus of the Barrington Democratic Town Committee and is married to Joan Arico. They have three children and three grandchildren together.
