



PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE
BARRINGTON TOWN
PROPOSED ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT

Pursuant to § 185-47, et seq. of the Barrington Town Code, the Barrington Town Council is holding a public hearing on Monday, March 3, 2025, beginning at 7:00 pm, in the Council Chambers at Town Hall (283 County Rd, Barrington, RI). The hearing's purpose is to solicit public insight and recommendation on proposed amendment to the Barrington Zoning Ordinance by the Bay Spring Crossing Condominium Association through Patrick J. Majewski, Association President.

The ordinance as proposed for amendment seeks to reclassify parcel AP 02, Lot 101, et al from a Residence-Business Flex (RBF) District to a new residential district titled, Residential-Multifamily (R-MF). The amendment would require text and Zoning Map changes. Also, the proposed amendment may be further amended/alterd prior to closure of the public hearing without further advertising by the Town Council, as a result of further study or because of views expressed at the public hearing, and any alternation/amendment must be presented for comment at the public hearing.
