AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT TO
THE ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF BARRINGTON

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Town Council of Barrington, Rhode Island, that the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Barrington be amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 33 – PERSONNEL POLICIES

* * *

§ 33-23. **Holidays.**


A. All personnel (prorated for less-than-full-time employees) not covered by a collective bargaining agreement shall be entitled to the following holidays:

- (1) New Year's Day.
- (2) Washington's Birthday.
- (3) Memorial Day.
- (4) Juneteenth.
- (4) ~~(5)~~ Victory Day.
- (5) ~~(6)~~ Columbus Day.
- (6) ~~(7)~~ Thanksgiving Day.
- (7) ~~(8)~~ Day following Thanksgiving Day.
- (8) ~~(9)~~ Martin Luther King, Jr., Day.
- (9) ~~(10)~~ Independence Day.
- (10) ~~(11)~~ Labor Day.
- (11) ~~(12)~~ Veterans Day.
- (12) ~~(13)~~ Christmas Day.

B. When a holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the following Monday shall be observed. ~~When a holiday falls on a Saturday, each employee may take off another day at his or her choosing within the fiscal year in which the holiday occurs.~~ Presidential Election Day and such other days as the Town Council shall from time to time designate shall also be considered paid time off.
