- 2022-13 An Ordinance Amendment to Chapter 144 Public Lands, Use of §144-15 Town Hall Business Hours

TM Comment: The public hearing on this Ordinance was originally scheduled for September 12th, but the Council continued it to tonight's meeting.

The proposed time change for Town Hall would close the building at 7 p.m. on Mondays, leaving the hours the same for Tuesday-Friday. Employees will still work a full 35-hour workweek, such as by taking shorter lunches or other arrangements approved by Department Heads. Departments report very few visitors during the hour between 7 and 8 p.m. on Monday nights. The proposed effective date is January 1, 2023.

President Carroll opened the public hearing for 2022-13 An Ordinance Amendment to Chapter 144 Public Lands, Use of §144-15 Town Hall Business Hours.

President Carroll asked if anyone wished to speak (in-person/via zoom). No one wished to speak.

President Carroll closed the public hearing.

Motion by Vice President Humm and seconded by Councilman Brier to adopt Ordinance 2022-14: An Ordinance Amendment to Chapter 144 Public Lands, Use of §144-15 Town Hall Business Hours, effective January 1, 2023.

The motion passed 5-0-0-0, in favor, President Carroll, Vice President Humm, Councilman Brier, Councilwoman Conway and Councilman Kustell no one opposed, no recusals and no abstentions.
